Now that you have decided to make a life commitment, we invite you to celebrate your wedding day with us in the heart of historic downtown Lynchburg. Located at the top of picturesque Monument Terrace, our beautiful Gothic chapel is perfect for a romantic ceremony; a setting suitable to honor the importance of your marriage.



Our chapel can comfortably accommodate up to 90 guests. While our Fellowship Hall, adjacent to the chapel, offers a comfortable space for a catered reception with a spectacular view of downtown. The Fellowship Hall includes convenient access to our well-appointed kitchen.



FEES

The total cost for a Wedding or a Service of Union is \$750, which includes the use of our Sanctuary, the services of our minister and organist, and decorations on the day of the wedding.

- Minister (rehearsal and wedding) \$350
- Sanctuary (rehearsal and wedding with decorations) \$250
- Organist \$150

If you wish to have your reception in our Fellowship Hall, the additional rental fee is just \$150.



We also offer the services of a professional decorator who can work with you to design floral and other aesthetic enhancements to the occasion. Costs based on services requested.

YOUR WEDDING CEREMONY

Whatever you believe, and whomever you love, whether you want a traditional ceremony, a Humanist ceremony, something "spiritual, but not religious" or neo-pagan, we impose no doctrine about what a ceremony must be like. Our minister will work with you to craft a ceremony that is a true reflection of your relationship and the sacred promises you will be making with one another.
